All currently registered adults with an active email address can access gsLearn. gsLearn can be accessed from any computer or electronic device with Internet capability.

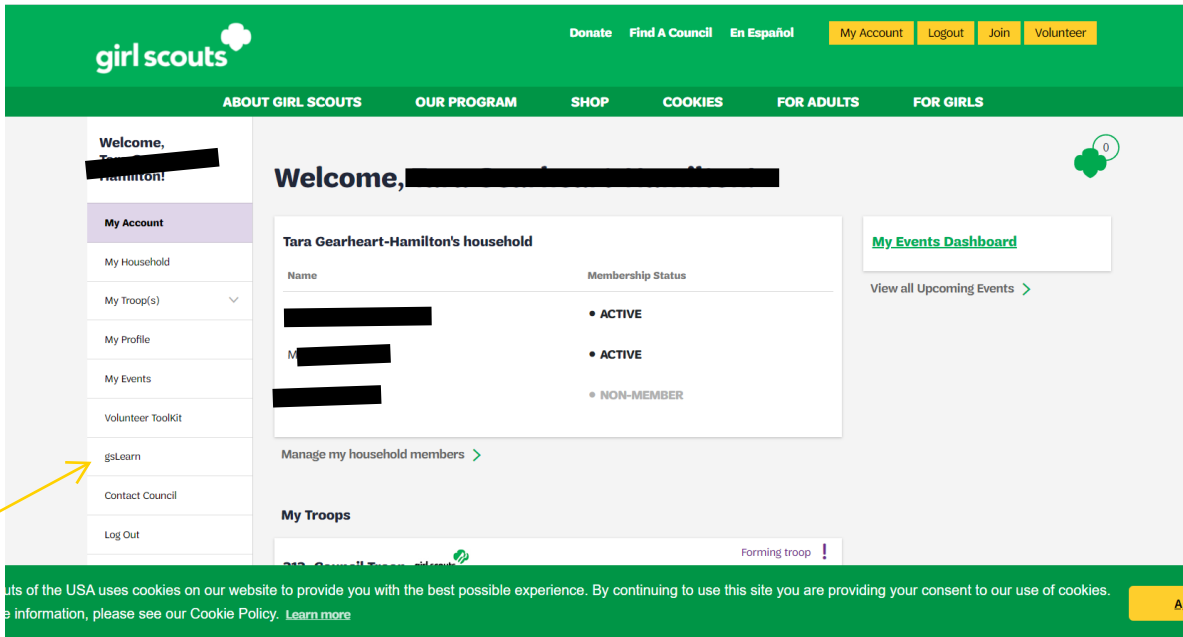
How do I login to my gsLearn account?

Navigate to: www.gskentucky.org

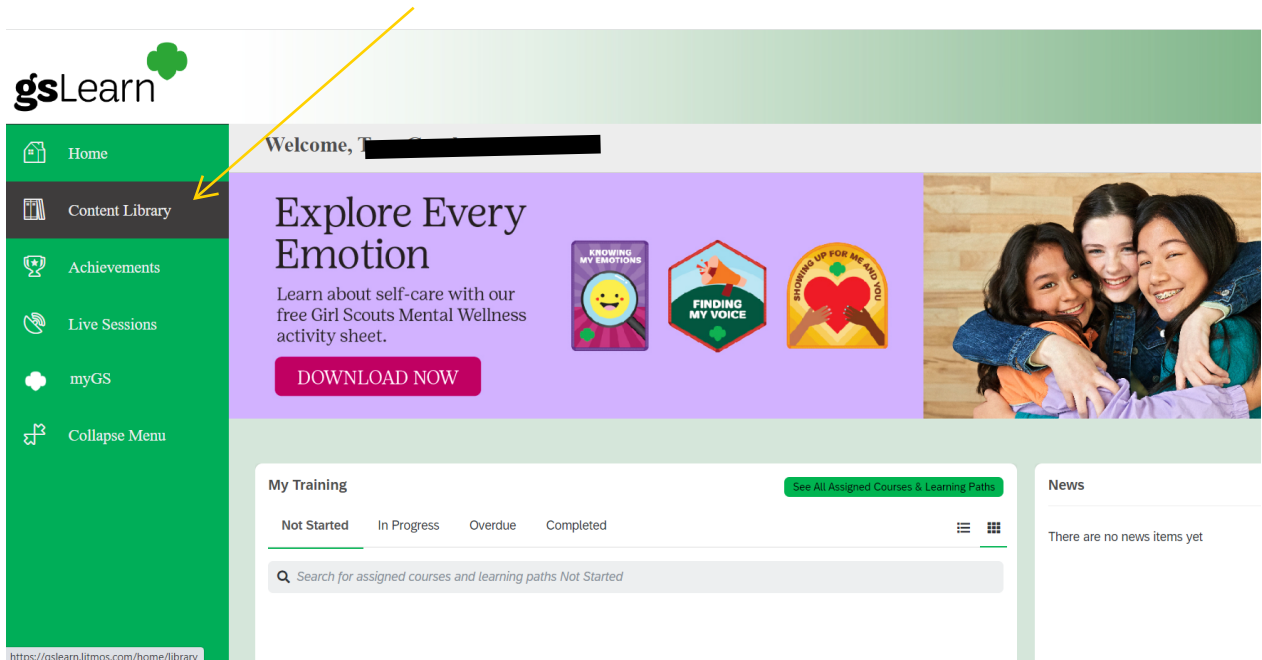
1. Click on **'My GS' and login.** Your My GS, Volunteer Toolkit and gsLearn share the same username and password. If you need your username or password reset, please reach out to your Coordinator for assistance. Once logged in you will click on 'My Account on the right side.

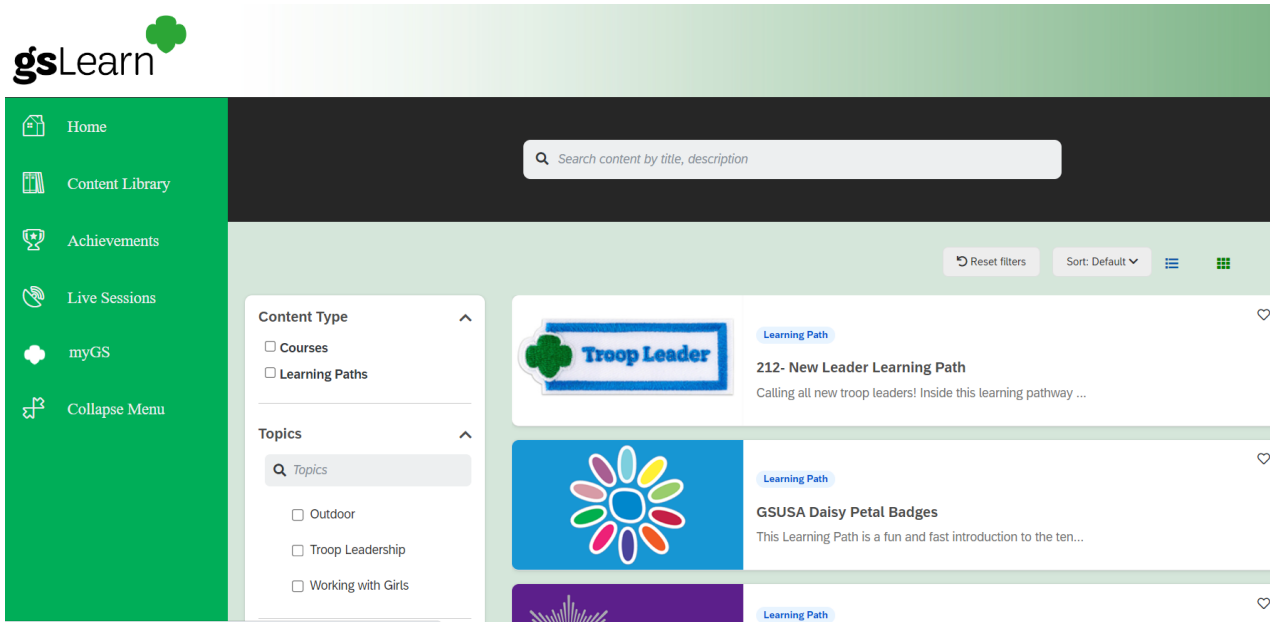
2. Once logged in, you will click on gsLearn on the left side of the screen.

gsLearn FAQ's

Q: Who can access gsLearn?

A: Any registered adult, with an active email address. No background check is required to access gsLearn.

Q: What training is required for Troop Leaders?

A: 212-New Leader Learning Path, 212- Welcome to Girl Scouts, 212- Volunteer Risk Management & Prevent Child Abuse in Kentucky. We recommend any volunteer signing on a troop bank account complete 212- Troop Finance Training.
