

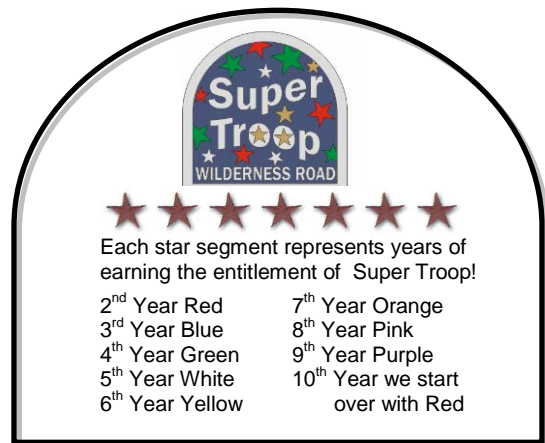
# super Troop

**Super: Higher in quality; surpassing all or most; superior in status**  
**Troop: A unit of...Girl Scouts under a leader**

All activities are to be completed during the current membership year (October 1 through September 30). Troops must be registered in order to participate. Each activity counts toward one requirement.

**The following are mandatory for Super Troops:**

1. The troop leader or her designated representative has attended at least 80% of her Service Unit meetings.
2. The Annual Troop Review has been turned into the Service Unit Manager.
3. Requirement \*4A, Council-Sponsored Product Sale Activities is mandatory for all troops.
4. A minimum of 125 points is required for earning this patch by Daisies, Brownies, Juniors, Cadettes, Seniors and Ambassadors.



1.	Registration (20 points max)	Points
a.	The troop re-registered by Oct. 1, all registration information correct and complete. (10 pts.)	
b.	New, never before registered troop registered before their third meeting. (10 pts.)	
c.	Based on Girl Registration, 50% of adults are registered and serve on the troop committee by the 3 <sup>rd</sup> meeting. (10 pts)	

5.	Growing in Girl Scouting (15 points each)	Points
a.	The troop has completed a Journeys during the current membership year.	
b.	Each active Girl Scout troop member earned one badge, patch, or Journeys Award during the membership year.	
c.	Each active Junior, Cadette, Senior or Ambassador troop member completed one requirement toward the Girl Scout Bronze, Silver or Gold Award during the current year.	

2.	Girl Membership (15 points max)	Points
a.	Troop registers as many girls in September as there were active in June. (10 pts.)	
b.	If a NEW TROOP, by November 30 have the minimum number of girls registered to meet policies: Daisy (5), Brownie (15), Junior (12), Cadette (6), Senior (5). Ambassador(10 pts.)	
c.	Troop registers additional girls by December 15. (5 pts.)	

6.	Diversity (10 points)	Points
a.	The troop participated in activities to promote respect for and appreciation of the religious, racial, ethnic, social, economic and special needs of our diverse membership. Programs may include Disability Awareness, Zink the Zebra, Program Passages, or other appropriate events or program.	

3.	Adult Training (35 points max)	Points
a.	The troop leader has completed Welcome to Girl Scouting. (5 pts.)	
b.	Troop leader has completed "Basic Leadership Training." (5 pts)	
c.	Troop leader has completed training appropriate to her troop's age level. (5 pts.)	
d.	Assistant leader has completed Welcome to Girl Scouting, Basic Leadership, and Age Level training. (5 pts each)	
e.	In addition to above training, leader or other registered adult(s) completed other Girl Scout training during the current membership year. (5 pts)	

7.	Service (10 points max)	Points
a.	The troop contributed service projects to the community during the current membership year with 75% of active troop members participating. (5pts. each)	

Service Projects are those which are meaningful to the troop members, are appropriate to their ages, interest and financial resources and are carried out in collaboration with another troop, organization, or a community. (Does not include Council cookie or Fall Product sale.)

4.	Council-Sponsored Product Sale Activities (20 points max)	Points
a.	Participated in Council cookie sale. *MANDATORY* (10 pts.)	
b.	Participated in Council Fall Product Sale. (10 pts.)	

<b>8.</b>	<b>Girl Scout Observances (10 points max)</b>	<b>Points</b>
a.	75% of active registered troop members took part in activities observing a special Girl Scout day (Juliette Low's Birthday, Thinking Day, Girl Scout Week, etc.) or special Council event listed in the TAP calendar. (5 pts. each)

<b>9.</b>	<b>Outdoor Program (30 points max)</b>	<b>Points</b>
a.	The troop participated in outdoor activities during the current year. Brownie and Junior troop activities may include at least one outdoor meeting or cookout or all-day outing. (10 points each)

<b>10.</b>	<b>Summer Activities (10 points max)</b>	<b>Points</b>
a.	50% of active troop members who were registered by June 30 <sup>th</sup> participated in a summer troop activity. (5 pts. each)

<b>11.</b>	<b>Girl Scout Visibility (10 points)</b>	<b>Points</b>
a.	75% of active troop members took part in activities which increased Girl Scout visibility in their community (flag ceremony for civic group, parade, uniform day, etc.).	

<b>12.</b>	<b>Bridging (5 points max)</b>	<b>Points</b>
a.	Bridging Troops: Troops took part in two activities with a sister troop of a different level which leads to a bridging patch. (5 pts. each)	
b.	Troops not Bridging: Troops took part in two different activities with a sister troop of a different age level which led to FUN! (5 pts. each)

<b>13.</b>	<b>Girl Recruitment (10 Points)</b>	<b>Points</b>
a.	75% of active troop members took part in activities to help recruit additional Girl Scouts (e.g. a meeting or event designed to invite non-scouts to see what the troop does (Add-a-Girl).	

<b>14.</b>	<b>Family Partnership (15 pts.)</b>	<b>Points</b>
a.	At least 50% of your troop parents have attended a Family Presentation or donated to Family Partnership.
