1. Flag Ceremony - Girls must at least be a Junior Girl Scout. Girls will carry the International Flag Collection into the arena to open the 100th Anniversary Celebration. Applications accepted through March 19 or until the maximum of 50 girls is reached. There will be one mandatory Flag Ceremony practice in May of 2012. Girls must wear Khaki pants or skirt, white blouse and a vest or sash.

2. Chorus -All age levels may apply. Girls must send in a demo tape to be considered for the chorus. Deadline to send in audition tape is February 19. The song that girls must sing on the audition tape is on the website/utube. The Chorus selected by March 19. Girls must wear Khaki pants, or skirt , white blouse and a vest or sash.
