SCHEDULE	DELEGATE ACTIVITY
September-October	<input type="checkbox"/> Election of all delegates council-wide
November-December	<input type="checkbox"/> Once elected, Delegate information is submitted to the Volunteer Department Director by December 1 st . <input type="checkbox"/> Once elected, complete the Delegate/Alternate Delegate online training. You will only need to take this course the first year that you serve as a Delegate.
February-March	<input type="checkbox"/> Attend your Spring Cluster area meeting to present and interpret Council Meeting agenda. After listening and participating in the discussion, base a vote on what will be in the best interest of the total Council.
April	<input type="checkbox"/> Come to the Annual Council Meeting fully informed in the Service Unit Association's view point on the agenda items, but not instructed on how to vote.
May	<input type="checkbox"/> Report back to the Service Unit Association on the results of the discussions and the actions taken at the Annual Council Meeting.
Throughout the Year	<input type="checkbox"/> Support decisions made at Kentucky's Wilderness Road Annual Meeting and report back to the community constructively and positively. <input type="checkbox"/> Actively listen to Girl Scouts (girls + volunteers) in your Service Unit throughout the year and represent their collective voices to the Kentucky's Wilderness Road Board and Staff.
