## What Parents and Girls Need to Know

### Who may attend?

Girl Scout Summer Day Camp is open to all girls ages 5-17, regardless of race, religion, national origin or ability. If your camper is not a registered Girl Scout, a \$12 membership fee must be included with the Day Camp Registration Form.

**A \$25 non-refundable deposit is required to hold a space in a session.**

### Where is day camp located?

Girl Scout Summer Day Camp is held at the Licking Valley Cluster Erlanger Service Center at 607 Watson Road, Erlanger, KY 41018.

### What are the hours?

Girl Scout Summer Day Camp runs from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Campers MAY NOT arrive at before 8:45 a.m. All campers must be picked up no later than 3:15 p.m.

### What does my child take to camp?

You will be sent a Girl Scout Summer Day Camp Confirmation Packet after the registration form is received. This packet includes all the information you need to prepare your child for a fun adventure.

### Does my child need a health examination?

**Yes.** A record of a health examination given by a licensed physician within the last 24 months is required. All records must be documented on a Girl Scout Day Camp Health Form that will be sent to you in your confirmation packet.

**Choosing a summer camp is a very important decision.** Girl Scout Summer Day Camps are structured to provide activities tailored to the age and experience of the camper girls. Day camp programs have the key ingredients: choices, challenges, physical activity, caring counselors, safety, and personal attention - to provide an overall quality experience for girls.

All day camp staff are trained, but more importantly, they are self motivated, to provide a positive and memorable experience for the girls. All staff have completed reference checks, background checks, and personal interviews, followed by comprehensive training prior to opening day.

Girl Scout Summer Day Camp meets the highest standards of health, safety, program, and staffing. Local and state laws and Girl Scouts of the USA guidelines are carefully observed.

## Registration Information

### Additional Daughter

Register more than one girl in the same family and get the additional daughter discount of \$5 off the second daughter's fee.

### Bring A Buddy

You may request to be in the same unit as a friend (same age level). Please include the name of your buddy on the registration form.

### Using Cookie Dollars for camp fees

You may use Girl Scouts of Kentucky's Wilderness Road Council Cookie Dollars to pay for Girl Scout Summer Day Camp fees.

### Refunds

The \$25 deposit is **non-refundable**. Fees are non-refundable, except in the case of camper illness or documented family emergency.

### Program Assistance

We don't want any girl to miss out on the fun of day camp due to financial concerns. Girl Scouts of Kentucky's Wilderness Road Council has a program assistance fund designed to help girls experience camping. This fund is due in part to Girl Scout individual and corporate contributions and product sales. ### Volunteering at Day Camp

If you enjoy being with girls and enjoy summer programs, then volunteer for a week of summer fun! We have a limited number of spaces for adult volunteers. Volunteer at day camp for the whole week and one camper goes to day camp FREE! Please see the registration form to become a volunteer. You must be a registered Girl Scout and have a Volunteer Criminal Record Check Release Form on file. Please include the \$12 GSUSA membership fee with your camper's registration form if you are not a registered Girl Scout.

### How to Register

- Registration is from February 13<sup>th</sup> – May 25<sup>th</sup>.
- Use the Girl Scout Summer Day Camp Registration Form in this flier. **Please use one form per girl per session.** Photocopy as needed. Form is also available at [gskentucky.org](http://gskentucky.org).
- To avoid processing delays, please fill out the registration form COMPLETELY and include parent/guardian signature.
- Enclose a **\$25 non-refundable** deposit to reserve your camper's place in the program. Make checks payable to GSKWRC.
- All registrations will be confirmed. A confirmation packet will be sent to each camper.

### Fees

- A **\$25 non-refundable deposit** is required at registration. You may choose to pay in full.
- Program assistance is available.
- The balance must be paid at least **TWO weeks prior** to the start of the day camp session.
