Cumberland Falls State Resort Park – Join us and Park Naturalists for an evening program, a hike to the Pinnacle Knob Fire Tower, a Potlatch Craft session and an animal program. Limited camping is available for a \$25/tent fee. For camping you must provide your own tent, sleeping bags, food, and any other gear.
