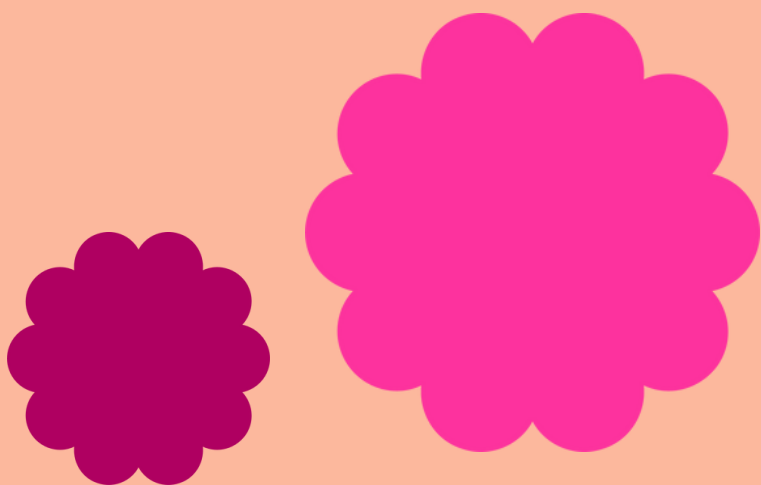

Design Your World Badge Challenge

Overview:

The “Design Your World Challenge” empowers girls to build financial literacy skills through hands-on budgeting and smart shopping experiences tailored to their age level. Girls will complete grade-level-appropriate badgework focused on money management, then create a personalized shopping wish list based on a set budget. Their chosen items will be purchased and shipped directly to them as a personalized reward for their financial planning efforts.

Girl Instructions:

- Complete Badge: Badge must be completed and signed off by troop leader or caregiver.
- Set Your Budget: Girls will receive a set budget (\$200) to "shop" within.
- Create Wishlist
- Use Amazon to select items that reflect their badgework goals (e.g., dorm gear, self-care kits, organization tools).
- Add items to a wishlist titled “Design Your World – [Girl’s First Name].”
- Include girl’s name and shipping address (verified by parent/caregiver).
- Submit for Approval: Submit wishlist URL and badge verification form via official Council submission form sent out in March-April.
- Receive Your Items: Girls receive their selected items by direct ship.

Rules & Requirements:

- Girl must be registered and participate in cookie program reaching the 6+ Spark Point designation
- Badge completion is required and must be documented (staff, leader, or guardian verification)
- Wishlist items must:
 1. Fall within budget
 2. Be age-appropriate
 3. Reflect the theme of the badge (e.g., organization, independence, shopping smart)
 4. Not include gift cards, tech devices, or luxury items
- All orders must be placed by Council — no parent reimbursements
- Council reserves the right to modify list if items are backordered or ineligible

Sign in to Amazon Account

- Hover over Accounts & Lists in the top right corner.
- Click Wish List or Create a List.

- Name your list: "Design Your World – [Girl's First Name]"
- Keep the Privacy setting as Public so it can be shared.

- Click List Settings on the right side of your list.
- Under List Address, Add a shipping address verified by a caregiver.

5

- Browse Amazon for items you want to add.
- On each item page, click Add to List → select "Design Your World – [Girl's First Name]".

6

- Click Send list to others or Share List.
- Copy the link to submit to the council form
