Goal

Prevent Child Abuse Kentucky is seeking to collaborate with Girl Scouts Troops throughout the state of Kentucky to create educational steps where members are given the opportunity to share public awareness through the planting of pinwheels (the national symbol for Prevent Child Abuse) during the month of April with the overall goal of earning a patch for this community service.

Wear Blue Day

As a part of Child Abuse Prevention Month, we encourage all Girl Scouts to wear blue on April 6th 2018. Pinwheel Patch Steps

In order for a Girl Scout to earn the Pinwheel Patchthe following steps need to be followed:

- 1. Site Selection: Educate girls on the goal of the Pinwheel Gardens. During the educational process the Troop Leader will share the importance of the project. Discuss various sites where the pinwheels could be planted or displayed in their community and set a plan with the girls on who to contact and what they should share with the location about the Pinwheel Garden Project. To earn a Pinwheel Patch, you need to have at least one planting or display site in your community during the month of April. For more information, refer to the Prevent Child Abuse Kentucky website at www.pcaky.org.
- 2. **Site Visitation:** Create a site contract plan during the month of March with a community location they feel is "visible" in their community. Girl Scouts will work with their Troop Leader to put together a verbal presentation to share with the site on the goal and objective for the Pinwheel Garden. Site Examples: Local schools, banks, parks, and churches.
- **3. Pinwheel Garden Agreements:** Work directly with a community site to set a time and date where the pinwheels will be planted.
- **4. Get your Pinwheels:** We encourage all troops to create your very own pinwheels. Visit: https://www.pcaky.org/sites/default/files/inline-files/PCAK%20CAPM%20Tip%20Sheet%20-%20Pinwheels%20for%20Prevention_1.pdf Pinwheels are also available for troops to purchase at a discounted rate of \$12 per box of 40 pinwheels. Available, while supplies last. See enclosed form to make pinwheel order.
- **5. Pinwheel Planting:** Each girl should plant at least 5 pinwheels at the site. Share your pictures of the pinwheel garden with us on Facebook (Girl Scouts of Kentucky's Wilderness Road), Instagram (@kygirlscouts) and Twitter (@kygirlscouts). Use hashtag #CAPM2018 and #kygirlscouts.
- **6. Site Cleanup:** The Girl Scout Troop in charge of the site planting will be required to remove the pinwheels after the planting. It is the responsibility of the Troop to work with the site to set up a removal date. The goal is to have the pinwheels shown in the community for a minimum of two weeks.
- **7. Patch Order:** Troops must complete a patch order form to receive the patch. Patches can be ordered for \$1 per patch.
